

2007 BOCCE LEAGUE

INFORMATION SHEET

- The season will begin the week of July 9th and run through the week of September 24th. A total of 12 games will be played.
- A team will consist of 2 people.
- Each team will play once a week, scheduled by the 2 teams playing, at their convenience, any day or night Monday through Sunday.
- 3 games will be played each session. The game is won at 12 points.
- Each game you win will be awarded 3 points. A tie game will be awarded ½ point for each team.
- The losing team will pay .25 cents per point, per person – double for a shutout.
- If a team does not show up for their scheduled game without rescheduling, it will be considered a loss and the forfeiting team will pay .25 cents per point (12 points), per player and the other team will be considered the winners (3 points awarded per game).
- Substitute players are allowed. If a player cannot make it a particular game/week, he or she is responsible to find their own substitute. You may choose a player either from within the league or not in the league as your substitute.
- The home team will be the first number team on the schedule for each session. When you are the home team, the session will be played at your home field (backyard??). Dario Frank has a bocce court right behind the fence of his back yard in the empty field, which he has offered for use. If you choose to use that court it is up to you to determine if it is available on the day and/or time you want to play.
- The end of the season barbecue will be on Saturday, October 6th at which time the top four games will play for the championship. A trophy will be presented to the winners. There will be no cash prize. The money collected during the season will be used to pay for (or at least towards) the party.
